

WINNERS' CHAPEL INTERNATIONAL, MILTON KEYNES **COMMUNITY BEHAVIOUR AGREEMENT**

The Church has a deep concern for the safety and well-being of each worshipper. Please find below a code of good conduct which every worshipper is expected to abide by. These are all temporary measures to see us through these times safely. God bless you richly as you comply.

Before arrival to the Church:

- Make sure you have registered along with all your household members who will attend the service, via the Church website.
- Children under the age of 4 and adults over the age of 70 are advised to continue worshipping online via the Church online streaming service.
- If you are driving, kindly park your car as directed by the Car Park officials. Do not get out of your car until there is sufficient space on the queue to accommodate you and your family.

On arrival in the Church Premises:

- Follow clearly marked-out flow of movement for people entering the church building.
- Maintain physical distancing of 2 metres at all times on the Church ground.
- Adhere to social distancing requirements at all times within the Church premises.
- On entering the church building, use the hand sanitiser provided and rub your hands with the sanitising gel adequately.
- Dispose of any tissue in the pedal-operated bin provided.
- Stay together with your household members in clustered seats within the Church hall as much as possible.
- Kindly submit to the temperature check conducted at church entrance; Anyone showing symptoms of COVID-19 (a new continuous cough, a high temperature or a loss of, or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell) should not attend the place of worship and would be asked to self-isolate and follow the government guidance.
- Keep facemask on as necessary.
- Avoid unnecessary movements, follow the one-way system – single entry and single exit.

During Church Service:

- Limit interactions with anyone they are not attending church service with.
- Avoid sharing of pens, books, Bibles, devices and other objects.

- Avoid touching properties belonging to others.
- Avoid singing loud, shouting or raising voices during worship.
- Use preferably contactless means for giving Tithes and Offerings.

Exiting the Church Premises

- Follow clearly marked out flow of movement for people leaving the premises.
- Maintain physical distancing of 2 metres at all times on the Church ground.
- Minimize the use of toilets as much as possible and follow rules on maximum occupancy.
- Try not to linger within the Church premises and ground.
- Ensure safe disposal of facemasks and other PPE items in pedal bins.
- Respect our neighbours by keeping the noise to a minimum.

Preventive Actions:

- When you cough or sneeze, cover your mouth and nose with a tissue, or the crook of your sleeved arm (not your hands) if you don't have a tissue, and dispose safely of the tissue immediately. Wash your hands thoroughly using soap and water or hand sanitiser.
- Anyone showing symptoms of COVID-19 (a new continuous cough, a high temperature or a loss of, or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell) should not attend the place of worship and would be asked to self-isolate and follow the government guidance.
- The Bookshop will operate only on pre-booking made on by contacting the bookshop.
- On leaving the church building please use the hand sanitiser provided.
- The children's section is out of bounds.
